Urinating in the event field

Following the previous visits to the Rutherford Laboratories and Rutherford Sports & Social Club for this particular round of the XC championships, which we Rutherford warmly welcome, we must bring to your attention the serious matter of those individuals who insist on urinating in the event field. These individuals being both male and female competitors.

In previous years individuals were spoken to at the event by Oxford XC League staff and RAL staff, but the issue persisted. One particular individual becoming very verbally abusive to myself in front of my 6 year old daughter when I requested politely that he find a proper toilet facility rather than using the field.

This year, if ANYONE is caught urinating in ANY PART of the field, the event will be halted INSTANTLY as RAL Staff will be present patrolling the field.

Anyone caught will be flagged to officials, and we will call for the event to be ceased.

We have neighbouring properties, some of which have elderly residents, and some very young children, all who have witnessed first hand people exposing themselves in full view of their properties. This is very quickly fed back to myself and in cases, site management which does not go down very well, and reflects negatively on the Sports & Social Club who is very keen to support these type of events, but with inconsiderate people repeatedly infringing the good will shown, it is becoming increasingly difficult to welcome events back.

Do not be the cause of having the event halted, and the event no longer being welcomed back. Use one of the supplied facilities laid on by the XC League and those belonging to the RAL Sports & Social Club.

This year there is ZERO Tolerance!.....
