



Oxon XC : Cirencester Cross Country Event December 2022

Traffic Management Plan

- Attendees are provided with advance information about travel and parking see Oxon XC Diary. In addition, the venue has been used for this event for some years and many participants participate each year and will be familiar with the venue.
- All vehicles attending the event park on-site there is no facility for parking on the public highway.
- All vehicles arrive and depart through the main gate for the Cirencester Park Polo club on the north side of the A419. The grid reference for that entrance is approximately SO987018. The What3Words address is ///laminated.aimlessly.gently
- We put up temporary signs by the A419 indicating the park entrance
- For the duration of the event, the gate to the Park is open so that vehicles can enter freely from the road.
- There is a long (nearly 1 km) private road between the A419 exit and the car park. This greatly reduces any risk that vehicles would be "backed up" on the A419 trying to get on site, other than westbound vehicles waiting for a gap in the eastbound traffic on the A419.
- We provide a team of volunteers who marshal vehicles in/out of the car park, further ensuring a smooth flow of traffic around the site.
- The site operates a one-way system that takes vehicles to the same access point for the A419.
- Participants arrive and depart throughout the morning from 08.30 until approximately 11.30. This is because the races include adult and junior age groups. The adult races are the last. Typically, this means that some parents arrive earlier for their children to race and some leave early, while many adults don't arrive until later in the morning.
- The largest outflow of traffic is from around 13.00 after the final adult races has finished.
- All traffic is off site by approximately 15.00
- In previous years, we took a fee for each car parked, allowing us to know the number of cars arriving. Typically this is around 500 cars but it does vary according to weather etc on the day. Similar numbers are expected this year.
